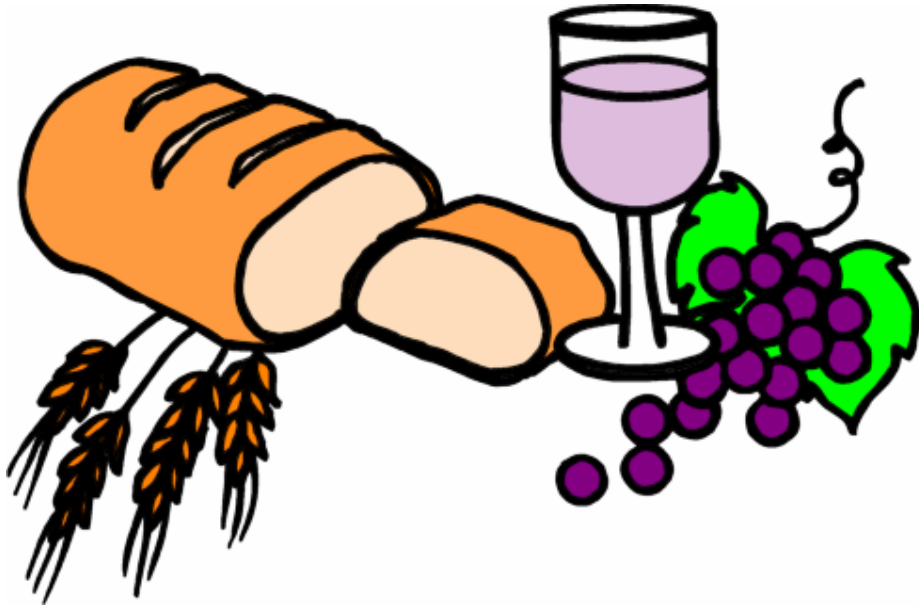


What is the Lord's Supper?



Today you will see bread and grape juice in church.

We eat bread and drink grape juice in church for a special reason.

On the night before our Lord Jesus died, he showed his friends how to remember him this way.

We call it the Lord's Supper. Another name is Communion, which means "sharing together."

Can you see the words
"In Remembrance of Me"
on the table up front?

People who believe and follow Jesus share the Lord's Supper together.

People who share the Lord's Supper have **asked Jesus** into their hearts.

People who share the Lord's Supper are **trusting Jesus** to be their Forgiver.

People who share the Lord's Supper are **following Jesus** as their Leader.
